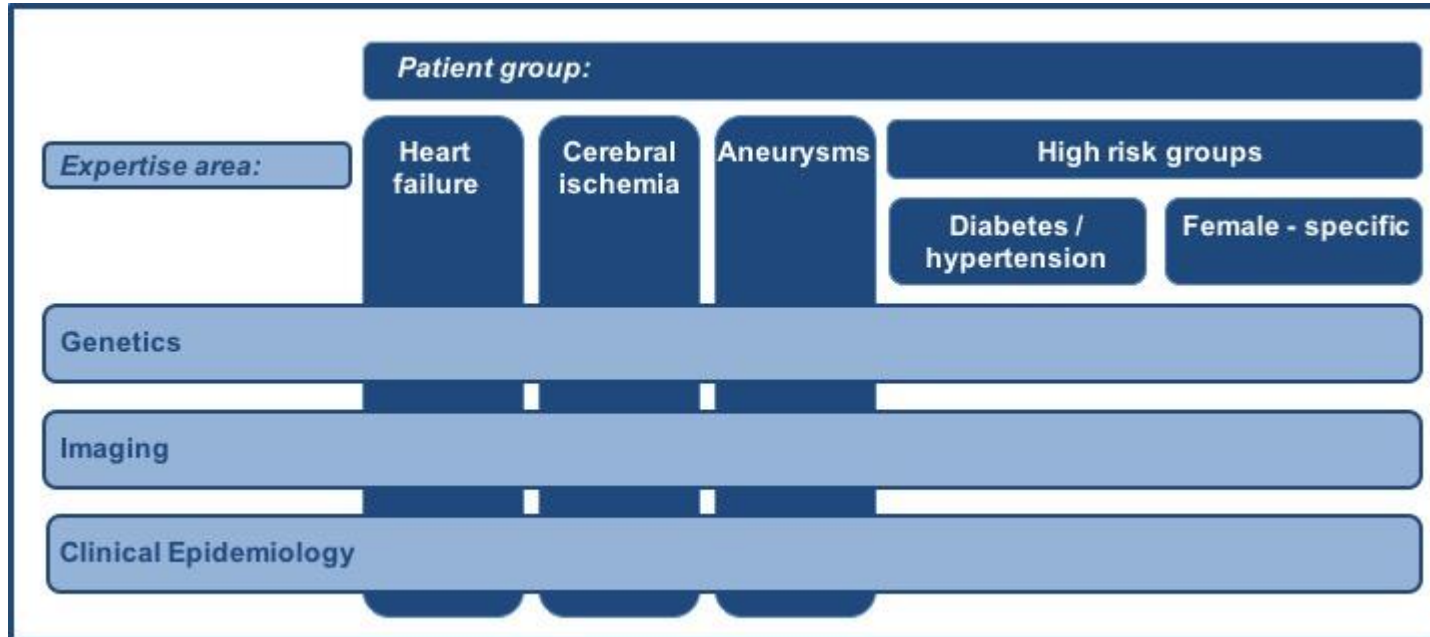
# Strategic theme Circulatory Health

UMC Utrecht:

- 1 in 4 patients have a cardiovascular diagnosis (annually more than 40.000 patients!)
- And 1 in 4 of those patients needs multidisciplinary care
